## ENGLISH

### **Topic: Articles (A/An) and Action Words**

1. With any 10 sentences demonstrate the correct usage of the articles 'a' and 'an' with names of wild animals (e.g., *an elephant, a zebra*).
2. Write simple action sentences describing animal activities using appropriate verbs (e.g., Birds fly, Monkeys jump).
3. Compose a short three-line poem based on a favourite wild animal, expressing creativity and imagination.

### **Topic: Animal Homes and Food Habits**

1. Classify animals based on their food habits into plant-eaters (herbivores) and meat-eaters (carnivores). Paste pictures accordingly.
2. List ten wild animals along with their respective habitats or homes.

### **Topic: Reptiles and Amphibians**

1. Collect and paste pictures of five reptiles and label them correctly.
2. Collect and paste pictures of five amphibians and label them accurately.

### **Topic: Using the Keyboard and Mouse**

1. Open a typing program and type "The Jungle is green."
2. Use the mouse to "Drag and Drop" animal clip-art into a forest background.
